## **State Mini-bulk Program Overview**

- Target states were Iowa, Indiana, Kansas,
   Nebraska, North Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin
- Mobile services deployed to Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska
- Mini-bulk programs managed in 14 states (additional states were added as States Request)
- Roughly 10,000 mini-bulks were recycled directly related to the PCCR in the TRI Rinse Program
- The flooding significantly delayed the mobile program



## **Keys to Success**

- These state programs are not viable without the support of the MANUFACTURERS
- The State Dept. of Ag, Associations and Universities provide feet on the ground
- Distributor provide important logistical support
- The industry asked for our help and we appreciated their support towards a successful program
- Dual prong programs mobile / collection to St.
   Louis to reach more customers

#### **AREAS TO IMPROVE**

- Work with Manufacturers to target states
- Get all distributors to participate with back hauls
- Educate the dealer on the spirit of the program to destroy and not repurpose to other industries
- Educate more dealers on the different types of containers
- Must be flexible to dealers who can't rinse the containers and need a full service company to handle the cleaning also



## 2012 State Mini-Bulk Proposal

- Target North Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin,
   South Dakota and possibly Iowa
- Utilize regional distributors to do back hauls
- Manufacturers to promote the program
- Promote program through the EPA, CLA, State
   Agencies and Universities
- Without this support the program is not viable
