EPA and PPDC Workgroups on Web-Distributed Labeling

- Database driven
- Deliver “use direction” labeling
 - state-specific
 - crop/site-specific
- Access by Internet or toll-free number



Secured to Container or Web-Distributed

- ❖ must be on label securely-attached
- ❖ should be securely-attached or accompany container
- ❖ could benefit user by Internet, fax or phone delivery
- ❖ Label is streamlined to their use pattern



Must be Securely-Attached - FIFRA § 2(q) and 40 CFR Part 156

1. Reference statement to directions for use found elsewhere in labeling
2. Use classification (RUP statement)
3. Violation of federal law statement
4. Product registration number
5. Signal word

Must be Securely-Attached - FIFRA § 2(q) and 40 CFR Part 156

6. WPS referral statements
7. Storage and disposal requirements
8. Product establishment number
9. Brand/product/trademarked Name
10. Ingredient statement
11. Net weight or contents

Must be Securely-Attached - FIFRA § 2(q) and 40 CFR Part 156

8. Product establishment number

10. Ingredient statement

Must be Securely-Attached - FIFRA § 2(q) and 40 CFR Part 156

12. Skull & crossbones/**POISON** and statement of practical treatment

13. Registrant name and address

14. Warning or caution statement

- protect health and the environment
- physical and chemical hazard information
- human health and environmental precautionary statements

Use Direction Reference Language

- You must obtain additional labeling from <http://pesticidelabeling.gov> or by calling 1-866-LABELING.
- You must possess a copy of this additional labeling at the time of application.
- It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its attached label or the additional labeling obtained in one of the methods listed above.

Use Direction Reference

- *unique identifier* - in addition to the product registration number
 - facilitate state-EPA-registrant registration synchronicity
 - ensure no contradictory labeling
 - more than one version of labeling for the same registration number
 - for any changes to label information that is securely-affixed

Example search fields for WDL

1. Unique identifier – web address
2. State – (county for ESPP)
3. Crop/site
4. Application Method or treatment type
 - Air, ground, chemigation, shank injection, backpack/hand
 - Labeling specific for use, mitigations and precautions for that particular use

Should be Securely-Attached – committee discussion

16.CHEMTREC and manufacturer phone numbers

17.For marketing or liability purposes,

- Company logo, graphics, or other identifiers (e.g., Organic Material Research Institute certification)
- Warranty statement

Web-Distributed Elements

- 19. Engineering Controls
- 20. **expanded*** Environmental Hazards
- 21. Resistance Management
identifiers
- 22. **expanded*** Storage & Disposal
- 23. Use Directions (refer to handout)

* if warranted

Web-Distributed Elements

- 19. WPS expansion
- 20. Allowable Sites, Crops, Hosts
- 21. Use Requirements
- 22. Use Prohibitions
- 23. Use Restrictions
- 24. Advisory Statements

Current Consideration

- Distributed web labeling (by phone) would include all label and labeling information
 - Repeat items that are securely-attached label items 1 – 18
 - relating to safety and product identification
 - All pertinent Use Direction items

Database Structure

- Database Tables
 - Dependent – relationship
 - Independent – stand alone
- Develop a hierarchical cataloging system
- Specific query extracts stand-alone and relational labeling

Codes for Label Dissection

- SA – stand alone
- Pest
- Crop
- Applic – application
- PC – pest & crop
- CA – crop & application
- PCA – pest, crop, application
- County
- Other
