- Written contract including documents required by Alabama's Legislative Contract Review Committee
 - Governors Additional Contract Questions
 - Disclosure Statement
 - E-Verify...
- Department legal counsel presents contract to legislative committee for approval
- Governor signs contract

Alabama Clean Day Program

- **The first pesticide collection in Alabama was in Baldwin County in 1994**
- **The program has never been funded by the state legislature**
- **The program is fully funded through Alabama's EPA grant**

Notifying the Public

- **Department mails out notices to our regulated community**
- **Cooperative Extension notifies their customers via phone or mail**
- **Radio stations and newspapers publicize the event**
- **Notice of the event is posted on the department website**
- **The department calls those who have contacted us and requested to be contacted for the next event**

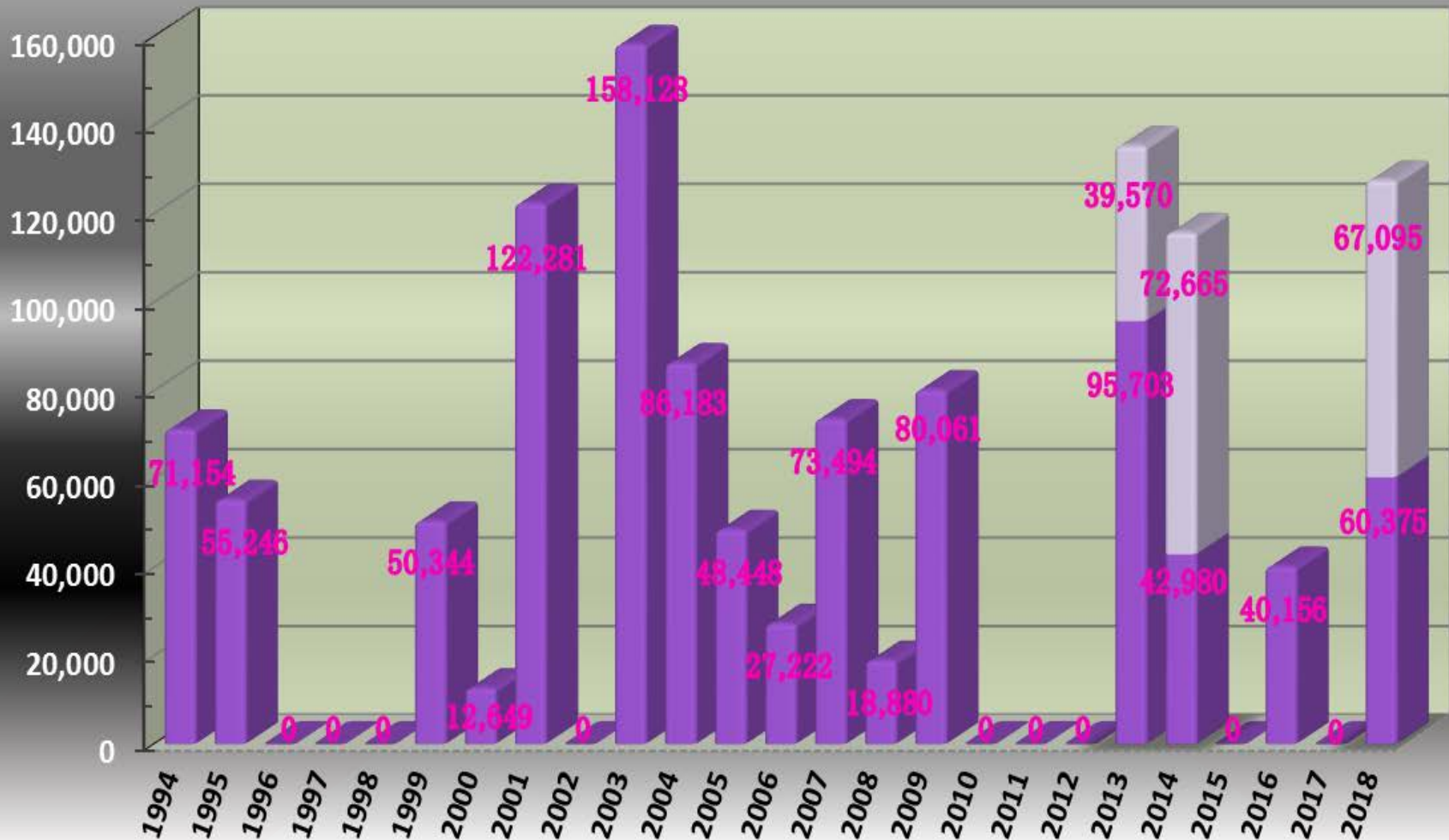

- **Events run from 8 AM to 12 PM**

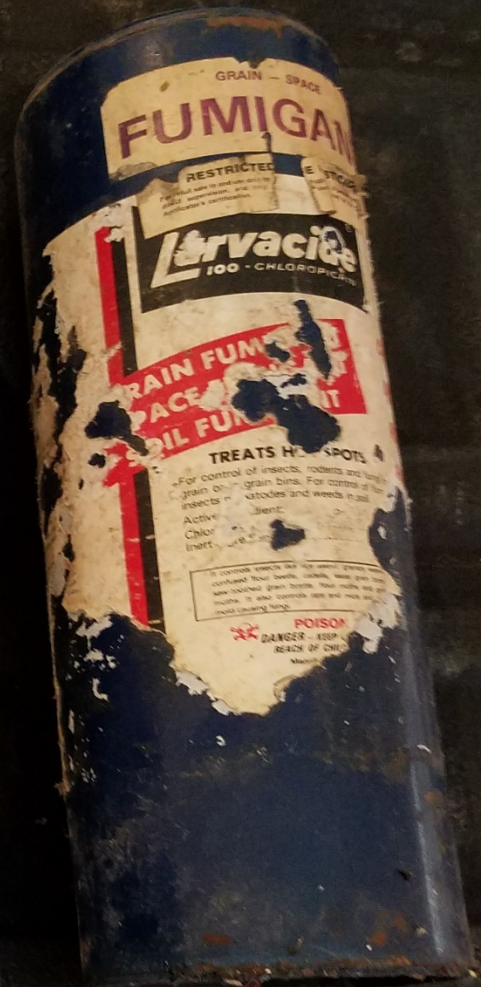
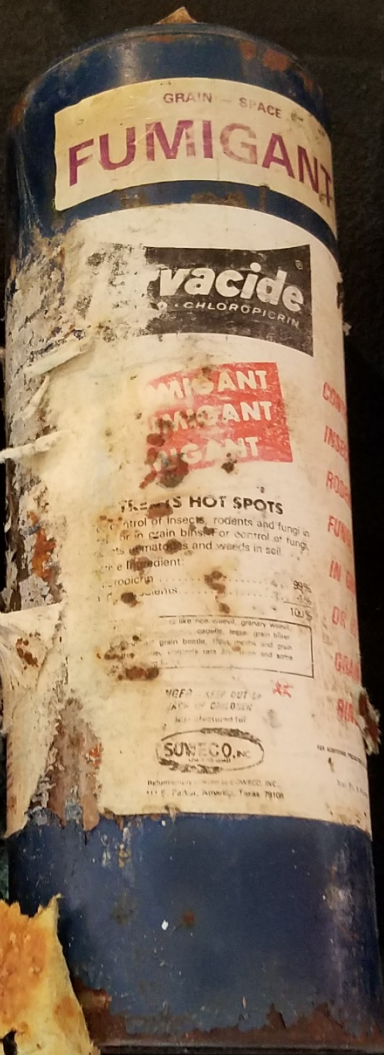
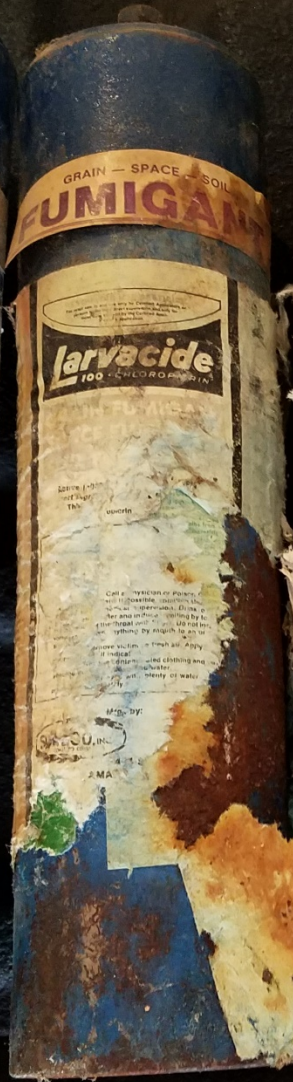
Collection Totals by Year
