What is MACA

- Mid America CropLife Association is an ag centered industry council serving 13 member states.
 - Mission: To be recognized as a leader with members collaborating to improve the safety, regulatory compliance, and awareness of agribusiness.
 - Membership includes manufacturers, distributors, warehouses, and allied members.
 - Committees include Distribution & Environment, Industry Communications, Annual Meeting, Pesticide Environment and Stewardship, and ad hoc committees as needed.
 - Key outputs of MACA: Young Leader Scholarship, seed and chemical warehouse assessment protocol, CropLife Ambassador Network, hazmat videos, industry focused training/speakers.



What is D&E?

- > The Distribution and Environment Committee focuses heavily on Distribution.
 - Heavy membership from warehouses but several others from distributors and manufacturers.
 - Main outputs: hazmat training videos, warehouse assessment protocols, regulatory speakers, waste forum.
 - Waste Forum: speakers from EPA, FIFRA, Clean Harbors, Heritage Environmental, State Activities.
 - One of the outputs of the waste forum was a flow chart. This flow chart does not take the place of any required training, it does not give you an answer, it gives you suggestions of things to think through.
 - Many different applications/uses: warehouses, manufacturers, distributors...anyone that is the owner or could cause the pesticide to be generated as waste.
